Other Information Concerning Eligibility

Eligibility Criteria: Any currently serving or dependent of a currently serving Washington National Guard Officer or Enlisted member who is also presently, or plans to be at the time of the award, registered as a full-time student.

Award Criteria: Applications must be postmarked no later than March 15th annually. Applications will be scored using the NGAW Memorial Scholarship Fund Committee SOP. A list will be created based on high to low points earned. The NGAW Board will determine the number and amount of scholarship(s) annually. The Scholarship Committee will make selections based on the application standings.

Application Criteria: Only fully completed scholarship applications will be considered. It is not the responsibility of the NGAW to notify applicants when their packets are incomplete. All three letters of recommendation must accompany the application.

Scholarship Payment: The scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient upon verification of full-time registration through transcripts with the institution indicated.

Eligible Schools: The award may be used at any accredited academic or vocational institution in Washington State.
